

CT CORONARY ANGIOGRAPHY REBATE CRITERIA

Medicare Rebates are available for CT of the Coronary Arteries. Medicare requirements for accessing CT Coronary Angiography rebates are very specific and must include certain clinical conditions.

To assist your understanding of the Medicare Rebate criteria we have summarised the data and provided the specific Medicare Rebate Conditions.

Please note that Calcium Scoring CT Scans are not eligible for a Medicare Rebate under any conditions.

CT Coronary Angiography 57350	Specialist Consultant Physician	<p>The patient has stable symptoms consistent with coronary ischemia, is at low to intermediate risk of coronary artery disease and would have been considered for coronary angiography.</p> <p><u>OR</u></p> <p>The patient requires exclusion of coronary artery anomaly or fistula.</p> <p><u>OR</u></p> <p>The patient will be undergoing non-coronary cardiac surgery.</p>	Payable once per 12 month period
